

English level 1 for SEG – 7 credits

Organisation: 2+1h/week all year round: no separation between theory and exercises (!)
Distribution of the students into various groups according to their last names: may slightly change in the next couple of weeks. **Attendance is important!**
Please, stick to your group!

Contents: Grammar review (tenses, modals, passive, reported speech, relatives, gerund and infinitive, adjectives, questions etc.). We do not start from scratch!

Market Leader textbook: introduction to business vocabulary, reading and listening comprehension, speaking (skills and case studies, role plays).

Material: Market Leader Intermediate (3rd edition! Centrale).
Syllabus (Grammar theory and exercises, vocabulary, etc.)

NB: If you do not have one, a grammar of reference (e.g. English Grammar in Use, 3rd edition, R. Murphy).

LISTEN TO: music, DVDs, cinema (OV), TV (BBC, VRT, CNN ...)

READ: Newsweek, Time Magazine, The Economist, FT, the Internet

SPEAK: meet the Erasmus students (ESN)

WRITE: do your homework!!! Chat, write letters...

Assessment: Exam: Grammar: 50%
Market Leader: 50% (vocabulary to and from English, listening comprehension, reading comprehension, and essay).

Oral exam: business simulation (business meeting, held in the course of the second semester, more info in the syllabus)

January exam: 25%

June exam: 50%

Business simulation: 15%

In-class case studies: 5%

Mini-tests (after each unit): 5%

If your mark in January is inferior to 10, your June exam will be worth 75% (same exam + extra grammar questions)
